## Budapest August 19-20

The race in Budapest, the Hungarian capital, is the Red Bull Air Race's equivalent to Formula One's Monaco Grand Prix. When you've had your fill of the action, check out the historical monuments and buildings.

### Széchenyi Chain Bridge

This suspension bridge spans the River Danube between Buda and Pest, the western and eastern sides of Budapest. The city's first permanent bridge, it was opened in 1849 and at the time of its construction it was considered a wonder of the world. It also became a symbol of advancement, national awakening, and the linkage between East and West.



### Buda Castle

Home of the Hungarian kings in Budapest, the first royal residence was completed in 1265, but the oldest part



of the present-day castle was built in the 14th century. It sits on the southern tip of Castle Hill, next to the old Castle District, which is famous for its medieval, Baroque and 19th-century buildings.

### Matthias Church

This church was originally built in Romanesque style in 1015. The current building was constructed in the florid late Gothic style in the second half of the 14th century and was extensively restored in the late 19th century.

### Citadella

Located on top of the Gellért Hill, the Citadella, or fortress, offers an amazing view of the city, the river Danube and its eight bridges.

### Hősök tere

Heroes Square is one of the major squares in Budapest and is home to the impressive Millennium Monument. It's located next to Városliget, a giant park in the heart of the city that contains a zoo, an amusement park, the National Museum, the world-famous Hungarian restaurant the Gundel, and the Széchenyi Thermal Bath – one of the largest spa complexes in Europe.
